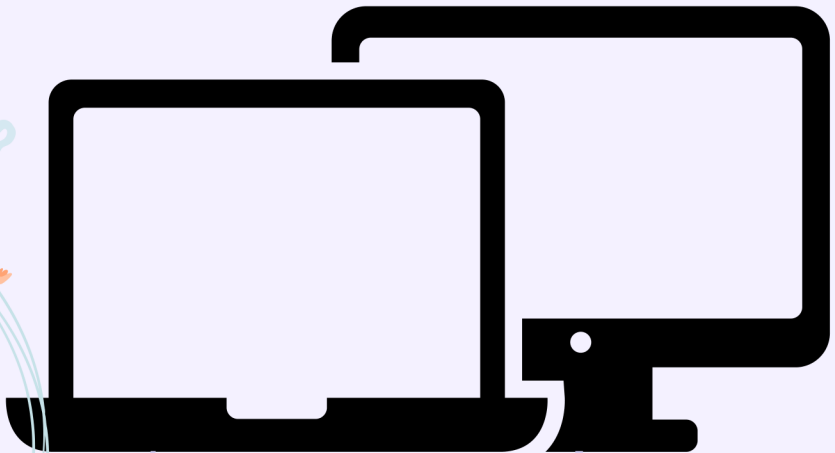
Introduction to Technology

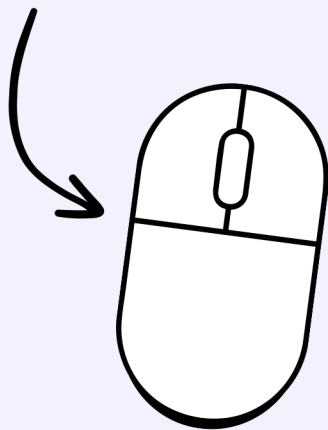


The Parts of a Computer

This is a mouse

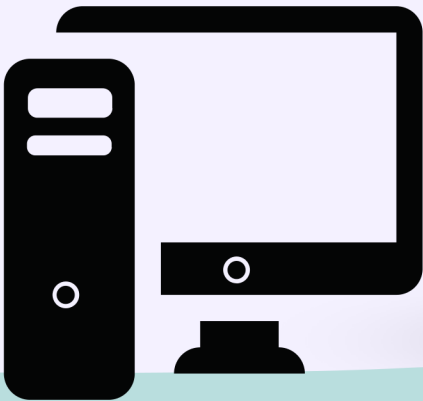


This is a keyboard



What is a Desktop?

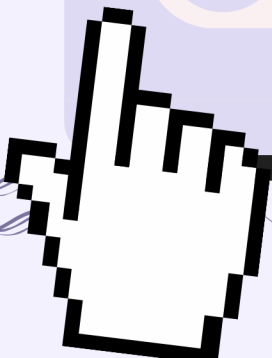

It has a big screen, a keyboard, and a mouse that you can use to control it.

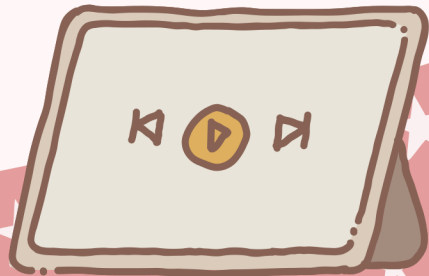
Laptop

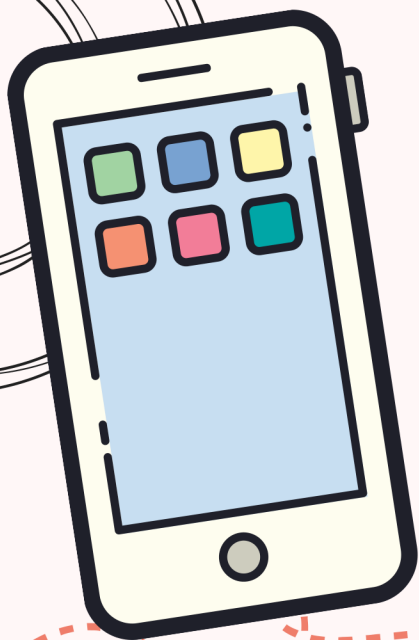


Tablet

Projector & Smartboard

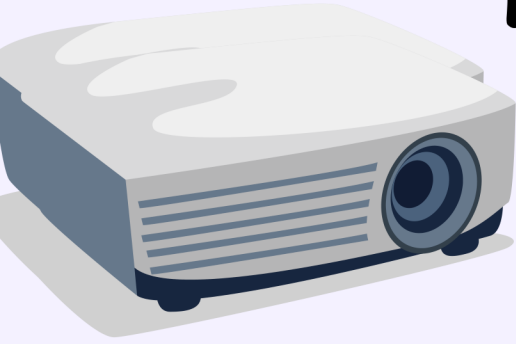
Projector

Q Internet safety is...

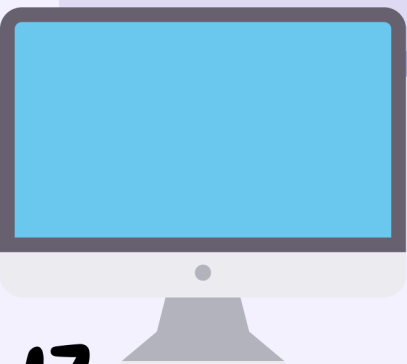
...Is all about staying safe online and protecting yourself against potential risks on the internet. These risks include viruses, scams, and strangers.



Stranger Danger

A Hacker is someone who uses their computer skills to explore or break into computer systems. Some hackers are good, but some are bad and help make systems more secure!

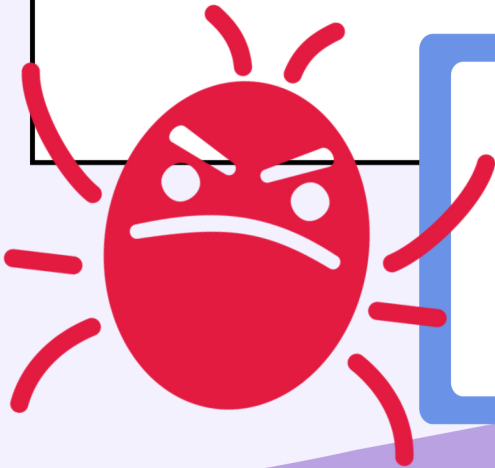
A troll is someone who plays mean tricks or says unkind things online to upset others. They might write mean comments or try to start fights. Always remember, it's important to be kind and respectful online!

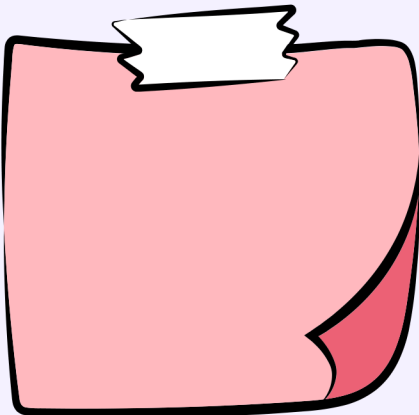
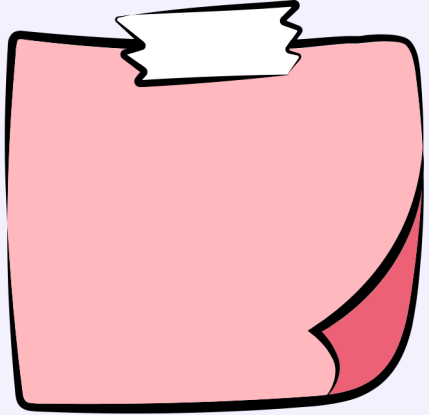
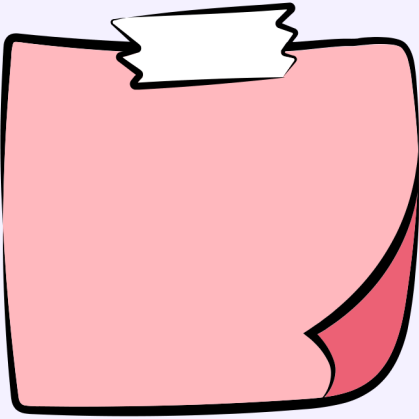
Conclusion
